Below is a limit of how many entries are allowed per youth in each category.

Display Exhibits - 2 display exhibits

Photography limited to 1 photo

Consumer Decision Making - 1 entry per youth

Seniors in-person or virtual. Seniors cannot do both in-person and virtual.

Beginners and Juniors virtually.

Fashion Revue – 1 outfit

Seniors in-person or virtual. Seniors cannot do both in-person and virtual.

Beginners and Juniors virtually.

Horticulture Skill-A-Thon - 1 entry per youth

Seniors in-person or virtual. Seniors cannot do both in-person and virtual.

Beginners and Juniors virtually.

Poultry Judging - 1 entry per youth

All age divisions virtual.

Public Presentations - 1 presentation

Seniors in-person or virtual. Seniors cannot do both in-person and virtual.

Beginners and Juniors virtually.

Rabbit Skill-A-Thon - 1 entry per youth

Seniors in-person or virtual. Seniors cannot do both in-person and virtual.

Beginners and Juniors virtually.

Special Foods - Youth in final year of 4-H membership will be judged for a bona fide ribbon placing.

Cookbook will be sold with recipes that youth submitted to the State Fair - Fair Entry this year. Previous years recipes will also be included.

Beef Cattle - 2 beef

Companion Animal - 2 animals, no more than one animal per lot

Dairy Cattle - 2 dairy cattle

Dairy Goat - 2 dairy goats

Meat Goat - 2 meat goats

Poultry – 2 poultry

Rabbit – 2 rabbits

Sheep - 2 sheep

Exception: if showing a Ram, only 1 sheep is allowed

Swine – 2 swine

Reminder that in animals shows with both Breeding and Market Shows, the limit is for Breeding and Market Shows combined. They are not allowed the number in each show. For example, Beef exhibitors are allowed 2 beef. They are not allowed 2 market beef and 2 breeding beef. The possible combinations include: 1.) 1Market Beef and 1 Breeding Beef, 2.) 2 Market Beef, or 3.) 2 Breeding Beef.

Belle Fourche 5th grader awarded 4-H heifer

Bristol Bachman, a Belle Fourche 5th grader and member of Butte-Lawrence County 4-H, was named the recipient of her very own heifer from the 2020 Heifers for 4-H essay contest that she entered in June. Bachman was announced as the winner of the contest on July 31 at the Youth Livestock Sale held at the St. Onge Sale Barn. The evening sale was held for area youth since this year's Butte-Lawrence County Fair was cancelled due to Covid-19 concerns.

The Heifers for 4-H contest was started six years ago in Butte-Lawrence county by Laney, Morgan and Clay Mackaben, children of Chad and Shawnie Mackaben of Belle Fourche. In 2013 after the Atlas blizzard, Laney and Morgan, who were 10 and 8 respectively at that time, each wrote a short essay and each received a heifer from Lusk, Wyoming 4-H members Dax Dockery and Monte Wade and their families. To "pay it forward" the Mackabens started the Heifers for 4-H program. For four consecutive years, they donated a heifer to a 4-H member, until those members' heifers have been in production and have a calf to donate back. This year's heifer was donated by past recipient Karlee Vavra's grandmother Linda.

Bristol will receive her heifer from the Vavra's this fall after calves are weaned. She will then show the heifer at the 2021 Butte-Lawrence County Fair, bring back the female with her calves to the 2022 and 2023 fair, and in 2024 "pay it forward" by donating a heifer to another 4-H youth member.

Bristol's younger sister Jessi, a Belle Fourche 3rd grader, also entered this year's Heifers for 4-H contest and is eager to apply for her own heifer again next year. The sisters are daughters of Jake and CharLee Bachman of Belle Fourche.
